wildPortfolio

Overview

Through out this document the terms 'Project' and 'Projects' refers to the text, url, and image file associated with each item that you place into the database using the wildPortfolio module.

The wildPortfolio module provides the ability to list projects in either a 'Portfolio List', which is 'images and text' format or an 'Image Only' format. Both of these optionally provide the ability to access more details on a separate page, through a 'more...' link option or you can use the image as the link to the details page.

The wildPortfolio module set-up options are modified through the 'Portfolio Options' page in DNN 2, and the 'Settings' page in DNN 3/4.

The wildPortfolio module contains 4 web user controls, designed and developed for the DotNetNuke (DNN) 2, 3, and 4 environments.

The user controls are for 1) Adding/Editing Projects, 2) Uploading Images, 3) Edit Templates and 4) Portfolio Options (DNN2)/Settings (DNN3/4).

Localization:

DNN2: See the Localization.txt file in the PA for instructions on how to tailor wildPortfolio to your location.

DNN3/4: wildPortfolio follows the DNN 3/4 specifications, which allows you to copy the existing resource files in wildPortfolio's App_LocalResources folder and to make the appropriate translation. Add these new files into wildPortfolio's App_LocalResources folder, but change the names appropriately. Example: the default or fallback language is US English, if you were to translate the wildPortfolioEdit.ascx.resx into Canadian French, then the translated file that you upload would be called wildPortfolioEdit.ascx.fr-CA.resx.

Through the wildPortfolio setup control, you have full control over the labels that are used for displaying project information and that are displayed on the input form. You can enter these labels in a language that is appropriate for your site. See screenshot under options.

The current version only supports Microsoft SQL!

Features: (the DNN2 version has not been updated to 1.3.5)

- Portfolio List with images or Images Only List
- Details page
 - Can be displayed within the page as List (see Details in Container)
- Configure Portfolio List and Details page content by clicking on checkboxes
- Labels can be over-ridden, or suppressed
- OR
- Enable and edit Templates for the Details page and Portfolio List or Images Only, using HTML and any of the 40 plus Tokens (see Template Tokens)
- Links:
 - Links can be External URLs or Internal Tabs
 - Links can be disabled, which allows you to turn the module into a Photo Gallery
 - Images can be used to link to URL or details page
- Images
 - Upload images/graphics using 'Upload Images' or single images through the Add/Edit Project page. Recommend using this method to upload pictures to

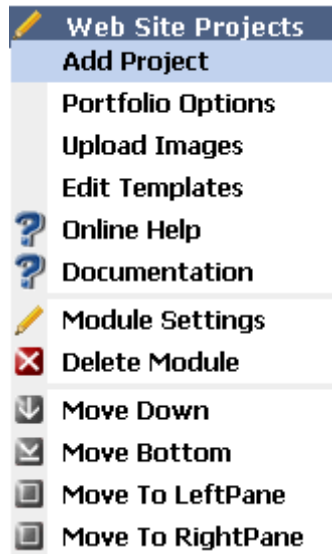
the appropriate folder, since it will re-size each of the images to fit into the default dimensions. For details see Images below.

- Upload images in a zip file, will be re-sized to settings in Portfolio Options for module
- Images can be positioned on the left, right or alternated from side to side
- Turn images off or on in the Portfolio list and/or the Details page
- Specify which text to be displayed above and below image in Images Only, or none
- Images can be placed in a module specific folder (see Image Location – *new in version 1.3.5*)
- Paging is implemented
 - indicate the number of projects displayed per page
- CSS styling
 - There are a number of classes that can be altered
 - set background and alternate colors in RGB
 - indicate a class for background and alternate background
 - styles for paging links
- Horizontal rule can be placed above or below or both
- Specify separate roles for
 - Portfolio Options/Settings
 - Add/Edit Projects and Upload Images
 - Permit editors to enter External URLs and/or select Internal Tabs
 - Permit editors to upload pictures, but only administrators can delete
- Control editing function access (see Edit Security – *new in version 1.3.5*)
- Click Through logging is supported, for all links, including Internal Tabs
- Multi-Language and Bi-Directional language support for DNN 2 see the Localization.txt file on how to achieve this. The DNN 3/4 versions follows the DNN core specifications.
- Install the module using the Host's File Manager, and upload as a Custom Module.
 - Add the 'wildPortfolio' module to a DNN page.
 - Modify the layout of the module's portfolio by selecting 'Portfolio Options'/'Settings', or use templates
 - Add Projects
 - Multiple modules on same tab, each with their own configuration and data
- Publish dates (Start and End dates) – *new in version 1.3.5*
- Auto-increment the order field – *new in version 1.3.5*
- Select Sort Order for output – *new in version 1.3.5*
- 'Full Description' field uses a 'Rich Text Box' for editing

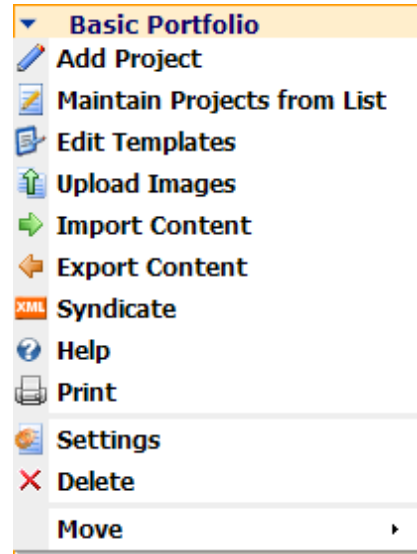

The above layouts show the different menu items in DotNetNuke 2 and 3/4. Note that the menu item 'Portfolio Options' do not exist in DNN3/4, but these options are available under 'Settings'. The DNN3/4 menu has a new item called 'Maintain Projects from List' which was added to help users/owners to see their own projects, and for the Administrator to assign projects to specific users.

The module has 11 text fields which vary in size from 50 characters to 2000 characters. You can name these 11 fields as you wish. You can change the 'Title' field to whatever you want but the label is never displayed, so renaming it would only be for the input screen (see below).

Fields and labels can be left blank.

You place the location of the output from these fields on either the Portfolio List or the Details page or both. You select the placement of the fields by selecting or de-selection the 'Display On' checkboxes for either Portfolio or Details.

The order in which these fields appear on the Portfolio List and the Details page are controlled by entering a number from 1 to 99 under the Order column for each field.

Images

Different width and height values can be entered for both the Portfolio List and the Details page. The dimensions that you enter for Portfolio are used to calculate the height value for Details. This makes sure that the values are proportional.

The displaying of an image on either the Portfolio List or the Details page is controlled by selecting or de-selecting the checkbox for each of the output types.

The location of the image is determined by selecting Left, Right or Alternate, which will display the image on the left side, right side, or alternate between the left and right sides.

Image formatting, determines the method of image sizing, during the upload of the file.

1. Crop Image: The smallest dimension is used to determine sizing, and the larger dimension is cropped to fit the dimensions specified above.
2. Fill Space: The largest dimension is used to determine sizing, and the background is filled with White or the background color as specified in the Layout section. The background color is only used if the BGColor is specified in RGB format (#RRGGBB) and either of the following is true: 1) the BGColor and Alternate BGColor are the same or 2) only the BGColor is specified.

Image Location was added in version 1.3.5. Selecting this option will allow you to place the images for this occurrence of the module into a separate folder. The folder will be a subfolder of wildPortfolio. For example, module 123, would have its images in folder: /Portals/n/wildPortfolio/123/

Note: Images are uploaded to a new subfolder of '\\Portals\n\' called wildPortfolio. Use the 'Upload Images' function on the Module dropdown menu or on the Project Add/Edit page. (see below).

Layout

This section of the Portfolio Options gives you control on how the projects will be displayed.

Images Only: if checked will display the Projects as hyperlinked images (the Title appears above the image and the URL below). The number of images displayed across the page is controlled by Max Columns. The fill order is controlled by 'Populate Direction'.

Image Upper Label: for Images Only, select the field to be displayed above the image, or select '<none specified>' to leave it blank. Enabled, if 'Images Only' is checked.

Image Lower Label: for Images Only, select the field to be displayed below the image, or select '<none specified>' to leave it blank. Enabled, if 'Images Only' is checked.

Show Labels: if checked will display the labels. If unchecked, then only the text will appear. Images Only ignores this option.

URL: allows the admin to turn off hyperlinks to external URLs or Internal Tabs

New Window: if checked the hyperlink will open a new browser window. The URL control allows you to override this at the project level. Don't depend on this being supported for long, at this level.

Display a Details Page: if checked will provide a link to a Details page, otherwise there will be no Details page.

Image as Details Link: if checked the image will be used as link to the details page.

Details Link Text: enter the text you wish to be displayed as the hyperlink to the Details page. Visible if 'Image as Details Link' is not checked.

Max Columns: a numeric value 1 to whatever. You will have to determine what is best for you site. The default is 1.
This is only used by the Images Only option.

Populate Direction: select either Down or Across. Down fills the left column first before moving to the next column. Across fills the first row, before moving to the next row.
This is used by Images Only.

BGColor: enter either an RGB string proceeded by '#', or a CSS entry. There are some CSS combination entries in the Module.css file called wildDefaultBG and wildDefaultAltBG, wildGradientTop and wildGradientBottom, wildGradientRight and wildGradientLeft, and wildGradientRight3 and wildGradientLeft3. These are for demonstration purposes, so feel free to add your own to the Module.css file (don't forget to put it back into the zip file and re-install).

Alternate BGColor: this works the same as BGColor.

Separator Height: enter the number of pixels you want displayed between each of the project entries. It will be the color of your Container's background.

Paging

This section of the Portfolio Options gives you control over paging of the projects.

Projects per Page: indicate the number of projects to display per page. Set the value to zero (default), the module will display all projects on a single page, as was done with the original module.

Previous Text: enter the text to be displayed as the hyperlink which causes the previous page of projects to be displayed.






Next Text: enter the text to be displayed as the hyperlink which causes the next page of projects to be displayed.

Navigation at Top: check this box if you wish the navigation links to be displayed at the top of the module.

Navigation at Bottom: check this box if you wish the navigation links to be displayed at the bottom of the module.

Note:

1. check both top and bottom boxes to have the navigation controls at both the top and bottom
2. between the 'Previous' and 'Next' links there will be displayed up to 10 page numbers as links to those pages,

Order

These options allow you to control the order that the projects will be displayed.

With Sort Order, you have the option to select from 3 different sort orders plus have the output in descending sequence.

The second option, 'Order', corresponds to an input field called Order which allows you to place a numeric value in this field. The Auto Increment option allows you to have the next value in a sequence automatically generated for you, but you must specify a starting value and the value increment the order. If you want the order to start with 1, then enter 0 as the 'Starting Value' and 1 as the 'Increment by' value. Even if you have enabled Auto Increment, you can override the numeric value that is generated.

Edit Security

The Edit Security options allow you to specify which group of users can perform which functions.

- The Administrator has full access and these cannot be overridden.
- The Owner group must be a registered user, especially if you wish to use the 'Owner can edit their own projects, ONLY!' option.
- Guests would be unregistered/anonymous users, as we use on the 'Try wildPortfolio' tab on the wildModules.com web site. This would allow you to restrict the functions that an unauthorized visitor could perform. A bit risky as they could put anything that they want on the site. We audit the contents on our site! On our site we do permit these visitors to upload images, but not to delete.

The 'Owner can edit their own projects, ONLY!' option allows you to restrict editing of projects to the person who created the project, and the Administrator. When a module has an edit role assigned to it, and there are users in that role, they will see the edit pencil for all projects, but only be able to edit their own projects.

If there are a lot of projects in a given module occurrence, then use the 'Maintain Project from List' menu dropdown. The projects listed on this page will belong to the logged in user, or all projects if you are the Administrator.

Maintain Projects from List

This page allows either the owner of a project or the Administrator to have a simple list of projects that can be edited, even if the display period has expired. Clicking on the edit pencil will present the user with the edit page (Input Page, see next topic).

Note: The Portfolio List and the Images Only list will not show projects which have expired, this page is the only way that you can get to those projects. This page is not available to a site visitor.

If you are the Administrator you can use this page to assign an owner to projects. You can select the individual projects or you can select all of the projects in a list by clicking on the 'Select All' button. To complete the assignment, select a user from the dropdown list and then click 'Update'. All projects which have been selected will be assigned to the selected user. The current list does not show the user's full name, and that will be updated in a future release.

There are two **new** fields added, in version 1.3.5, which can effect whether a project is displayed or not.

These fields are 'Start Date' and 'End Date'.

If these fields are blank then the project is always displayed.

If there is a 'Start Date' and 'End Date' then the project is only shown on and between those dates. Start and End dates can be the same date.

If there is a 'Start Date' and no 'End Date', the project will be shown beginning on that date and from then on.

If there is an 'End Date' and no 'Start Date', the project will be shown from the time of update up to and including the 'End Date'.






Note: if the new label name is blank then the original field name is displayed. This was done so that you would see which field it is, if you blanked a label.

Note: you can log clicks, by enabling the checkbox. The default is not to log clicks.

Notes:

- The image sizes will vary depending on the values that you enter in the Images section of the Portfolio Options.
- Each module can have different image size; the upload process will re-size the images to fit your settings.
- Image sizes are displayed on the Upload Images page.
- Thumbnails are displayed to assist in determining which picture you want to use.
- For security reasons, only Administrators can delete the images. This will allow you to permit editors (that is anyone you assign to that role) to upload images.

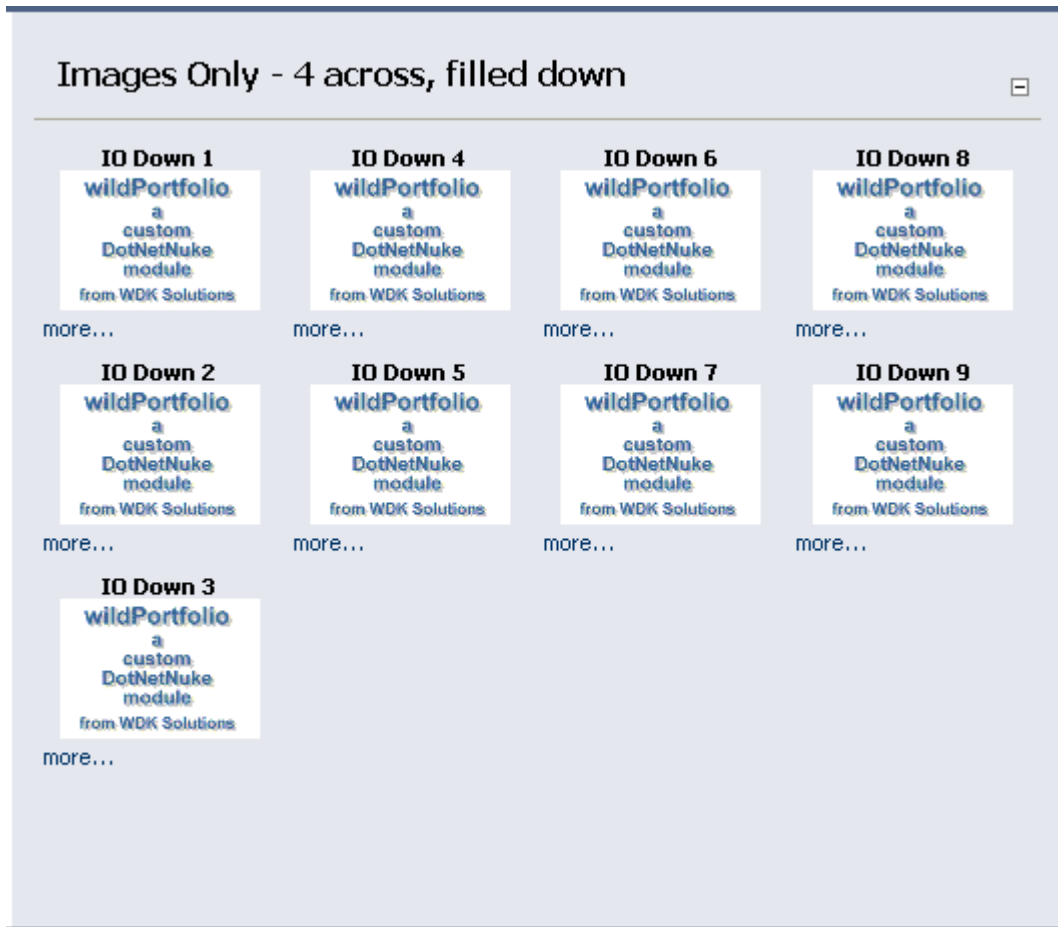

Trouble Shooting

Question: Why doesn't a new image show in 'Images Only' display after it was just added.
